WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science lost 13.7 points

30.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 44.1% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Math narrowed by 4.6 points

Limited English Proficient sat 21.8 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 17.2 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math gained 13.9 points

43.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 29.8% in 2024–25.

Math is 10.6 points below the state

Gould Elementary School reported 34.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Math gained 5.8 points

34.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 28.8% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Science lost 13.7 points

30.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 44.1% in 2024–25.

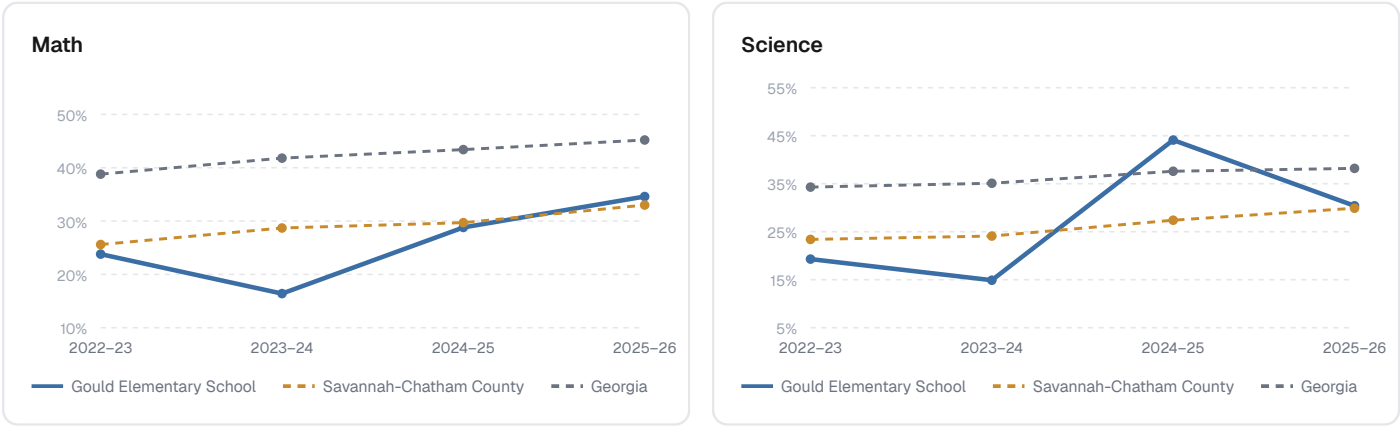
