Findings for 2025–26

Science gained 5.0 points

25.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 20.5% in 2024–25.

Grade 3 Math gained 21.5 points

29.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 7.8% in 2024–25.

Math is 28.1 points below the state

Haven Elementary School reported 17.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Math is 15.9 points below the Savannah-Chatham County average

17.1% here vs. 33.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math gained 4.9 points

17.1% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 12.2% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Math lost 7.6 points

10.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 18.2% in 2024–25.

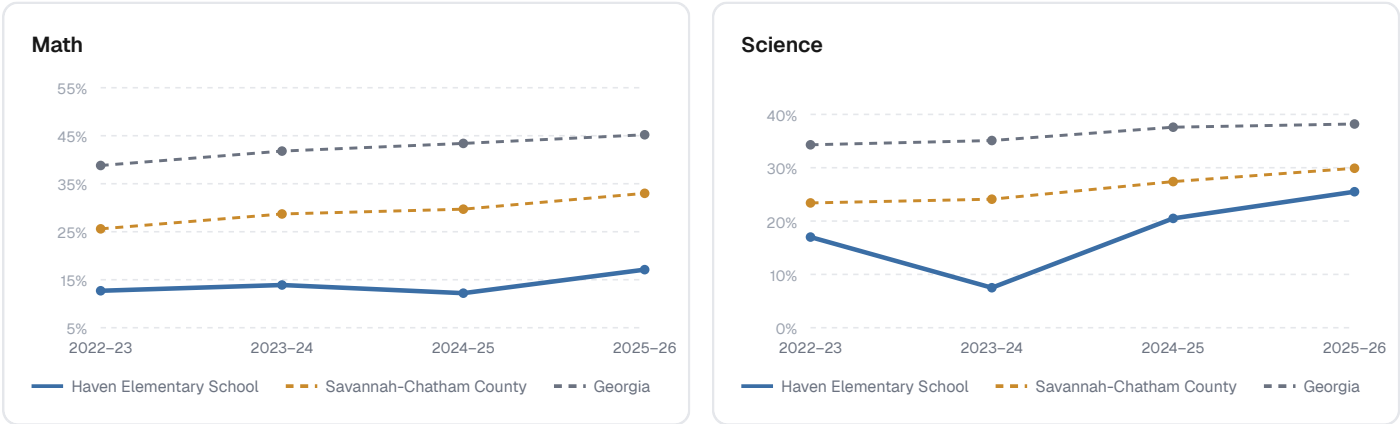
