Findings for 2025–26

Science lost 6.2 points

31.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 37.7% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Math lost 11.9 points

20.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 32.3% in 2024–25.

Math is 14.2 points below the state

Hodge Elementary School reported 31.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Math lost 6.1 points

31.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 37.1% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Science lost 6.2 points

31.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 37.7% in 2024–25.

Science is 6.7 points below the state

Hodge Elementary School reported 31.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

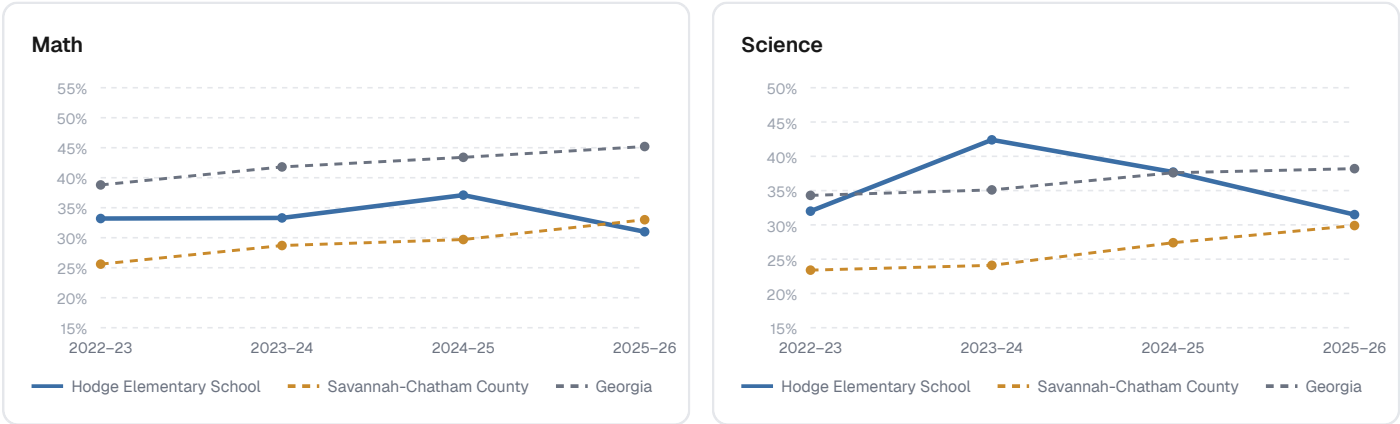
