WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Social Studies gained 10.5 points

17.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 7.0% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Math narrowed by 4.9 points

Limited English Proficient sat 6.5 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 1.6 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 8 Social Studies gained 10.5 points

17.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 7.0% in 2024–25.

Math is 35.2 points below the state

Hubert Middle School reported 10.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Math is 23.0 points below the Savannah-Chatham County average

10.0% here vs. 33.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science gained 5.5 points

10.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 4.7% in 2024–25.

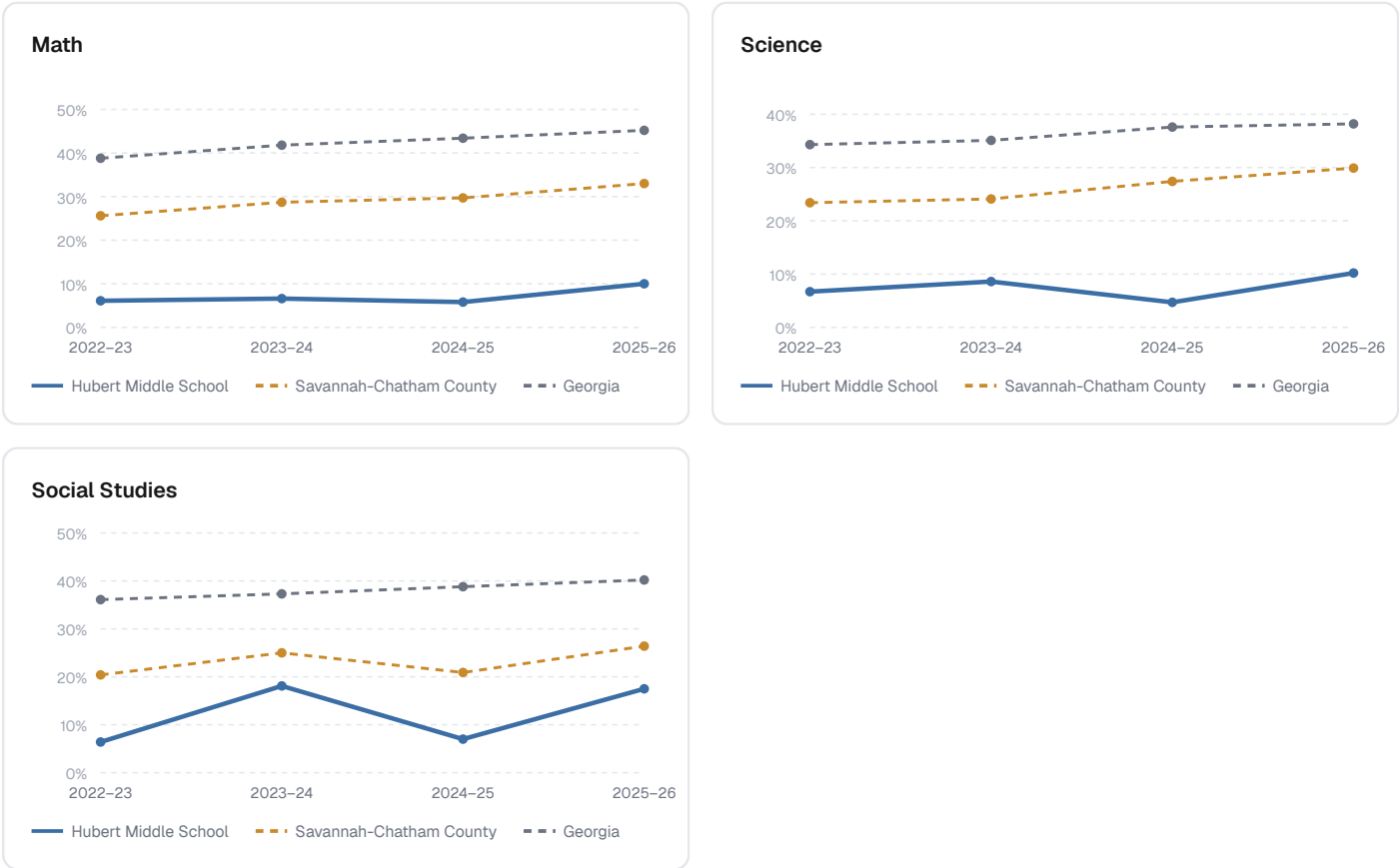
