Science gained 10.4 points

59.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 48.6% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Science gained 10.4 points

59.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 48.6% in 2024–25.

Science is 20.8 points above the state

Jacob G. Smith Elementary School reported 59.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 29.1 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

Math gained 2.3 points

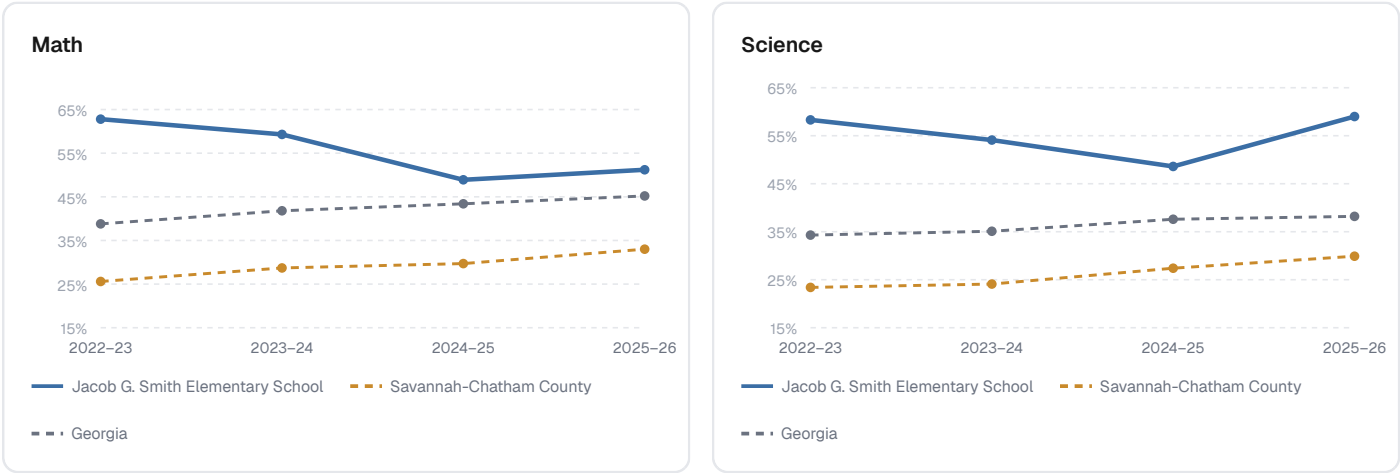
