50.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 61.9% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Science lost 11.9 points

50.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 61.9% in 2024–25.

Math is 20.2 points above the state

May Howard Elementary School reported 65.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Math is 32.4 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

65.4% here vs. 33.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math lost 3.4 points

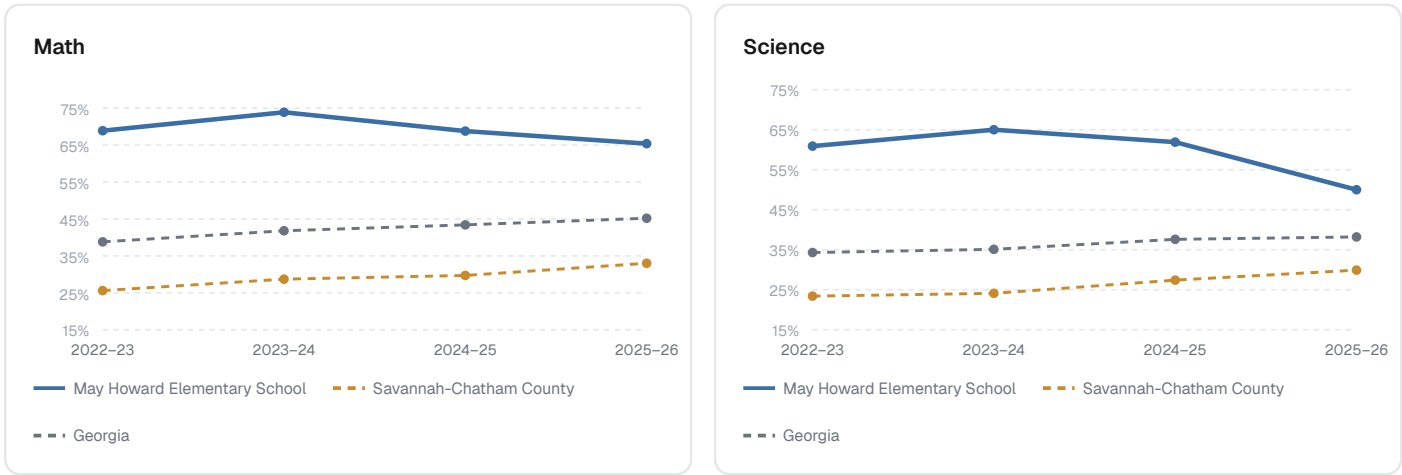
