WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Algebra: C&C gained 14.6 points

33.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 18.8% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

6.7% → 6.9% → 7.9% → 11.6% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+4.9 pts overall).

The Limited English Proficient gap in Social Studies widened by 8.7 points

Limited English Proficient sat 23.6 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 32.3 points behind them in 2025–26.

Science is 34.4 points below the state

Mercer Middle School reported 3.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 26.1 points below the Savannah-Chatham County average

3.8% here vs. 29.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

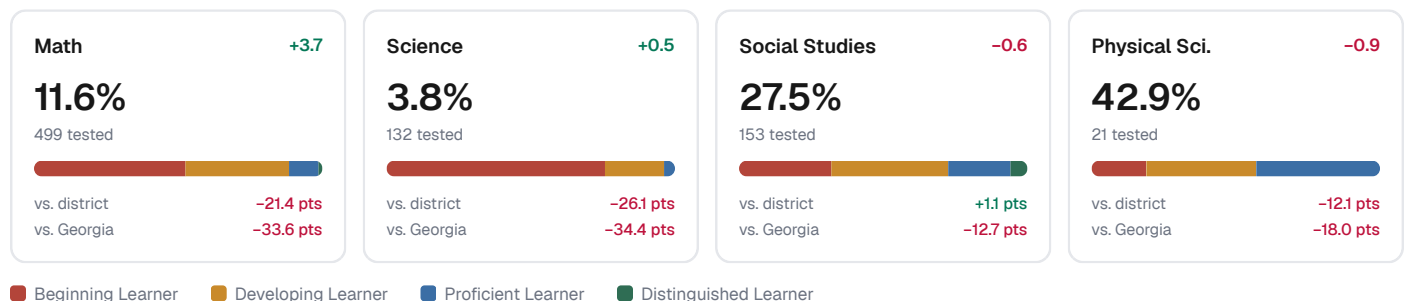
Math gained 3.7 points

Performance by subject

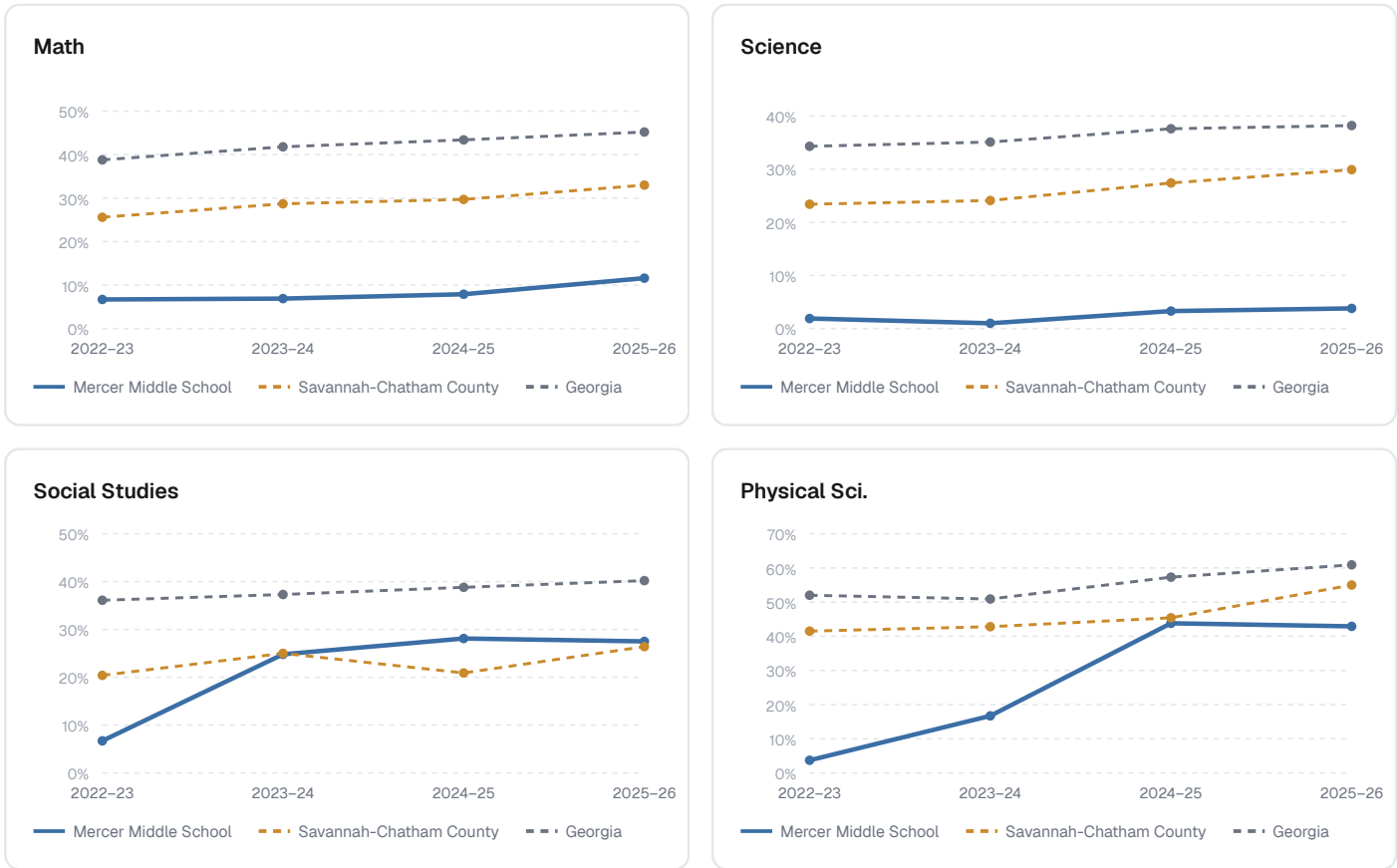
Percent of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished, with the change from last year and the distance to the district and state averages.
