WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Algebra: C&C lost 5.3 points

4.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 9.5% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 5.5 points

Students with Disabilities sat 7.8 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 2.3 points behind them in 2025–26.

Algebra: C&C is 43.9 points below the state

Myers Middle School reported 4.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 48.1%.

Algebra: C&C is 28.6 points below the Savannah-Chatham County average

4.2% here vs. 32.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Social Studies gained 3.9 points

10.9% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 7.0% in 2024–25.

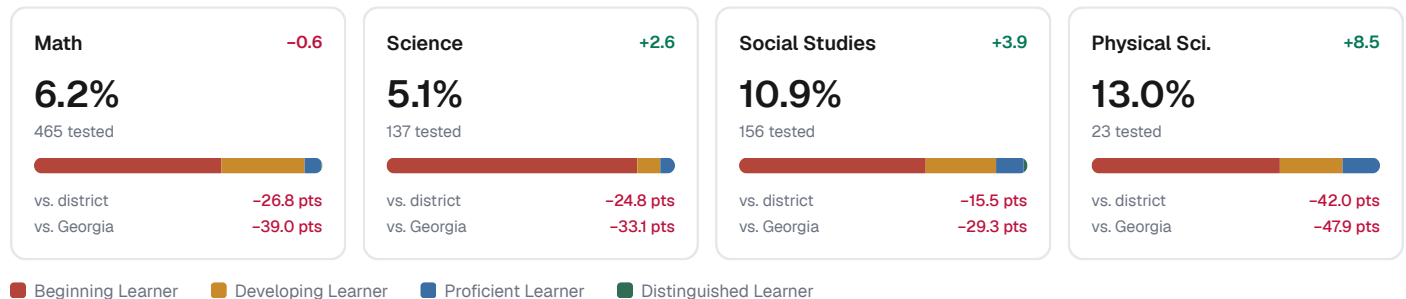
Math is 39.0 points below the state

Performance by subject

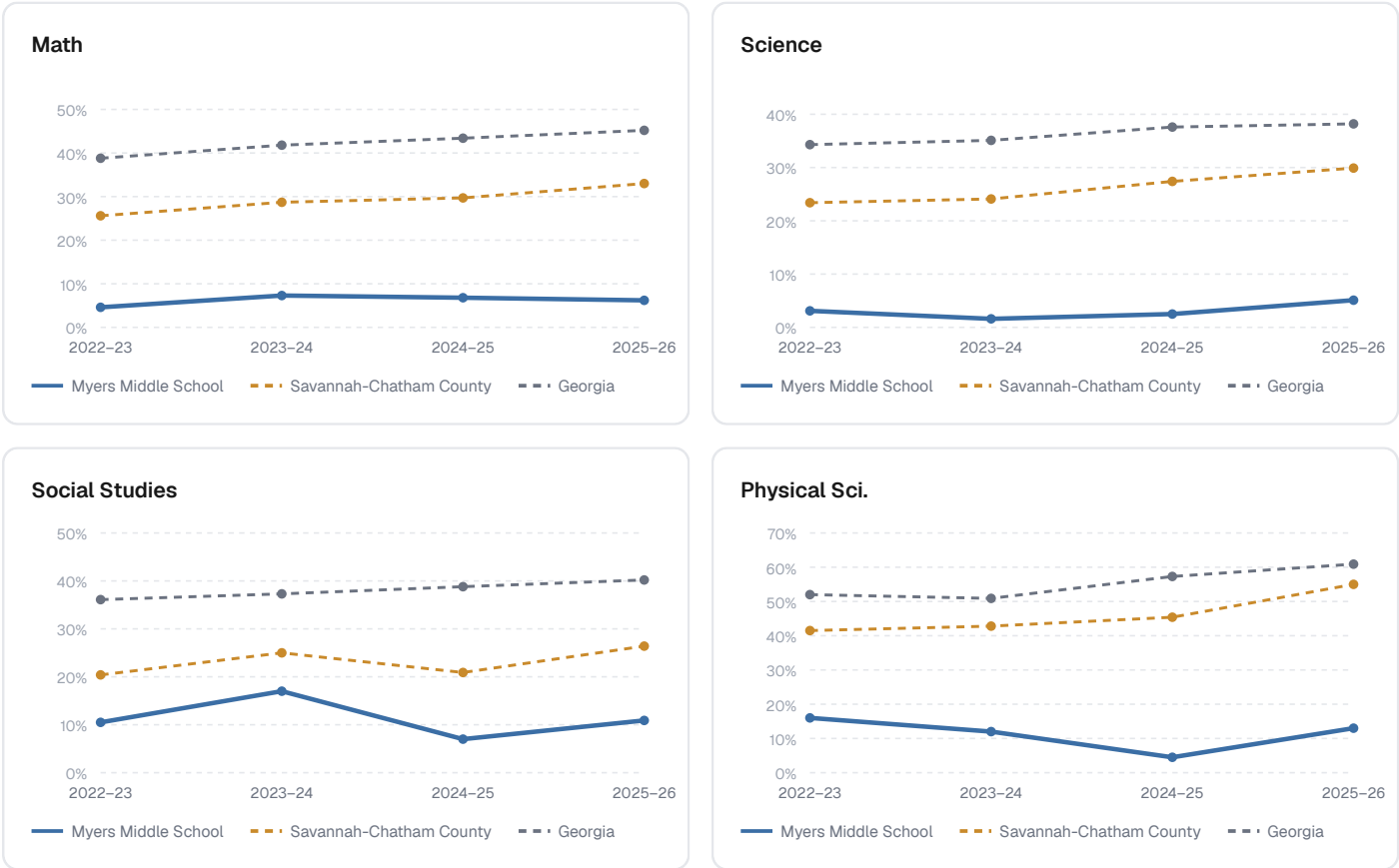
Percent of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished, with the change from last year and the distance to the district and state averages.
