WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science gained 16.1 points

42.1% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 26.0% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Science widened by 7.6 points

Limited English Proficient sat 30.9 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 38.5 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 5 Math gained 21.1 points

44.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 23.2% in 2024–25.

Social Studies is 21.9 points below the state

New Hampstead K-8 School reported 18.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 40.2%.

Science is 12.2 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

42.1% here vs. 29.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math gained 7.5 points

32.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 24.9% in 2024–25.

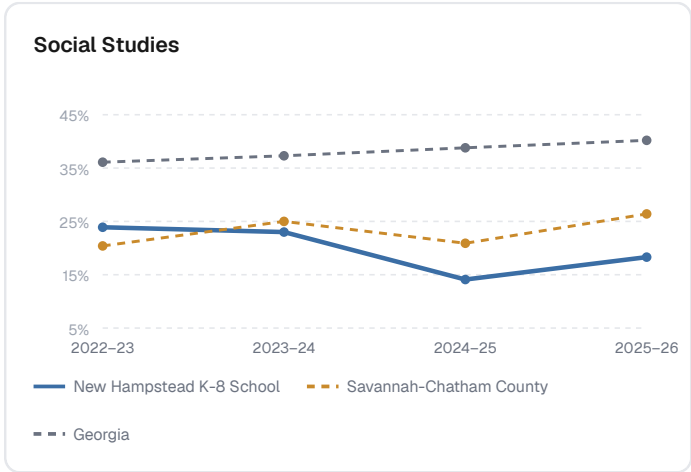
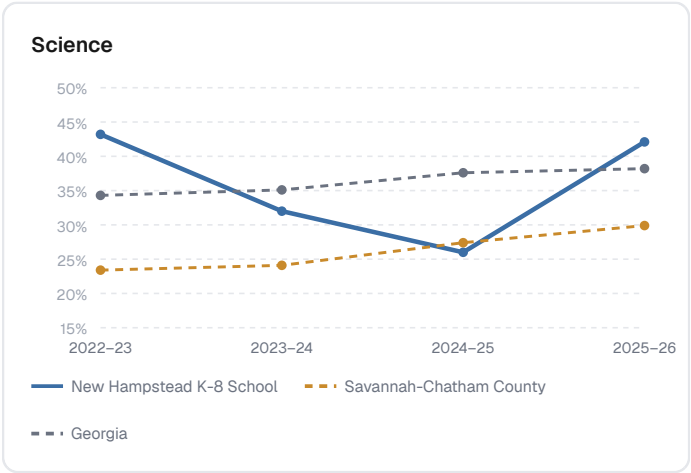
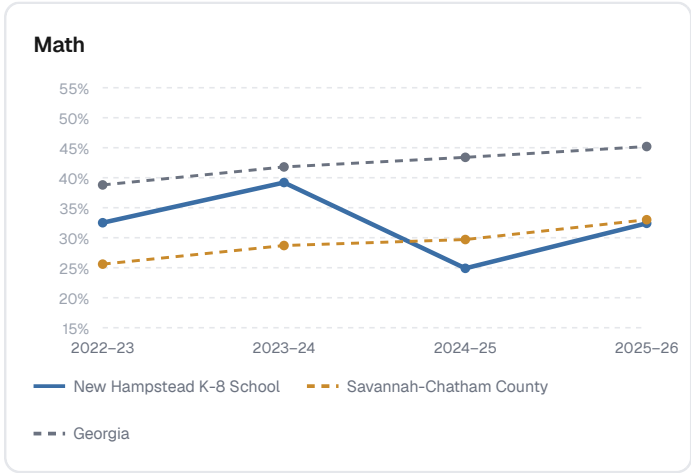
