WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Algebra: C&C gained 26.0 points

76.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 50.0% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Social Studies narrowed by 8.0 points

Students with Disabilities sat 6.6 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 1.4 points ahead of them in 2025–26.

Grade 6 Math gained 8.6 points

18.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 10.1% in 2024–25.

Social Studies is 32.6 points below the state

Oglethorpe Charter School reported 7.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 40.2%.

Algebra: C&C is 43.2 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

76.0% here vs. 32.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

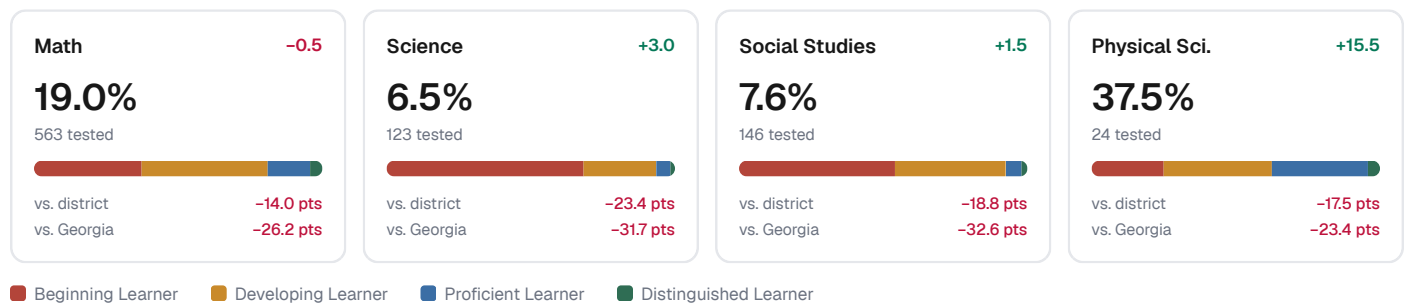
Science gained 3.0 points
