WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 5.9 points

31.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 25.5% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

21.6% → 25.0% → 25.5% → 31.4% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+9.8 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math widened by 17.3 points

Students with Disabilities sat 19.1 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 36.4 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math gained 18.1 points

44.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 26.0% in 2024–25.

Science is 17.1 points below the state

Otis J Brock III Elementary School reported 21.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 8.8 points below the Savannah-Chatham County average

21.1% here vs. 29.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

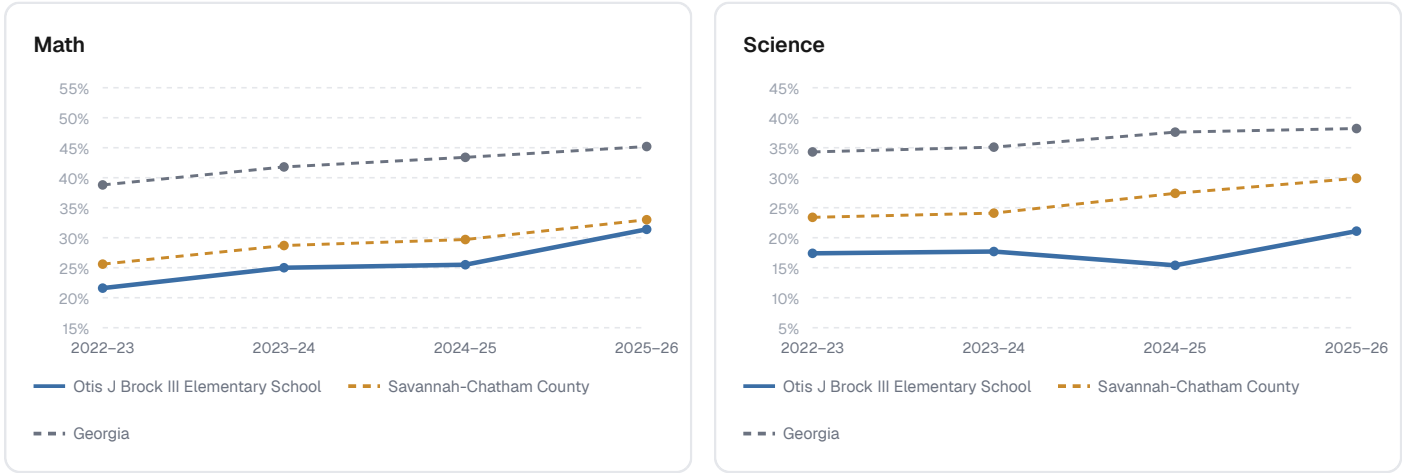
