WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 5.9 points

32.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 26.1% in 2024–25.

Science has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

27.5% → 27.7% → 27.9% → 32.8% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+5.3 pts overall).

The Limited English Proficient gap in Math narrowed by 17.8 points

Limited English Proficient sat 27.2 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 9.4 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math gained 14.5 points

35.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 21.3% in 2024–25.

Math is 13.2 points below the state

Pooler Elementary School reported 32.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Science gained 4.9 points

32.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 27.9% in 2024–25.

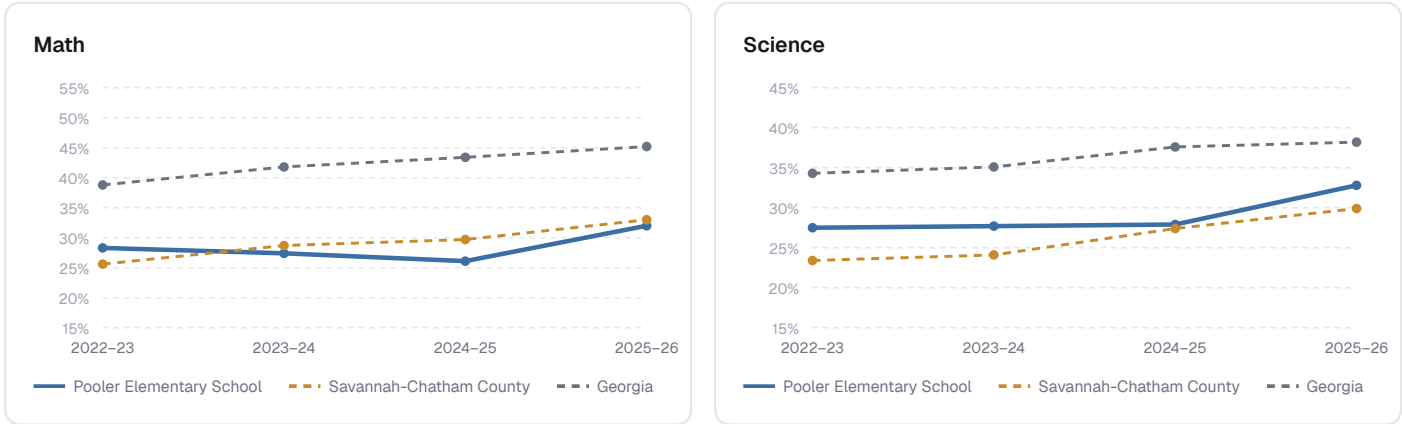
