Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science gained 32.7 points

43.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 11.1% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Science gained 21.1 points

43.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 22.7% in 2024–25.

Math is 31.2 points below the state

Savannah-Chatham E-Learning Academy reported 14.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Biology is 24.5 points below the Savannah-Chatham County average

17.9% here vs. 42.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

US History gained 16.6 points

21.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 5.0% in 2024–25.

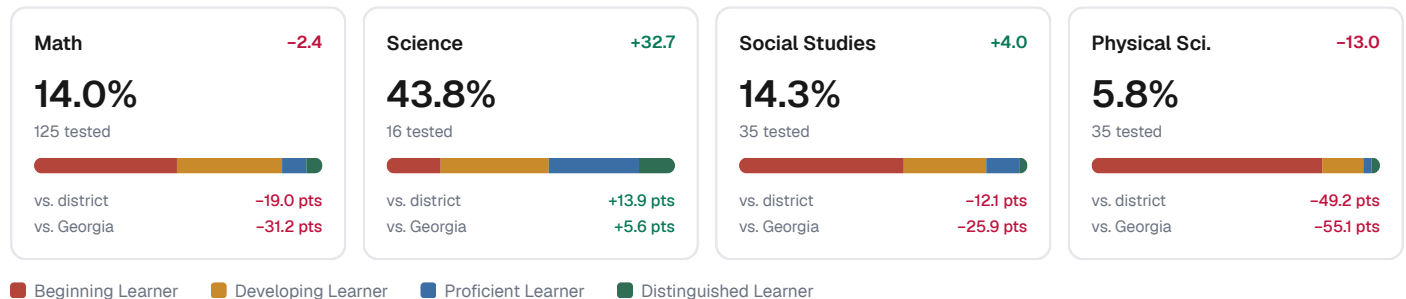
Grade 5 Math gained 13.2 points

Performance by subject

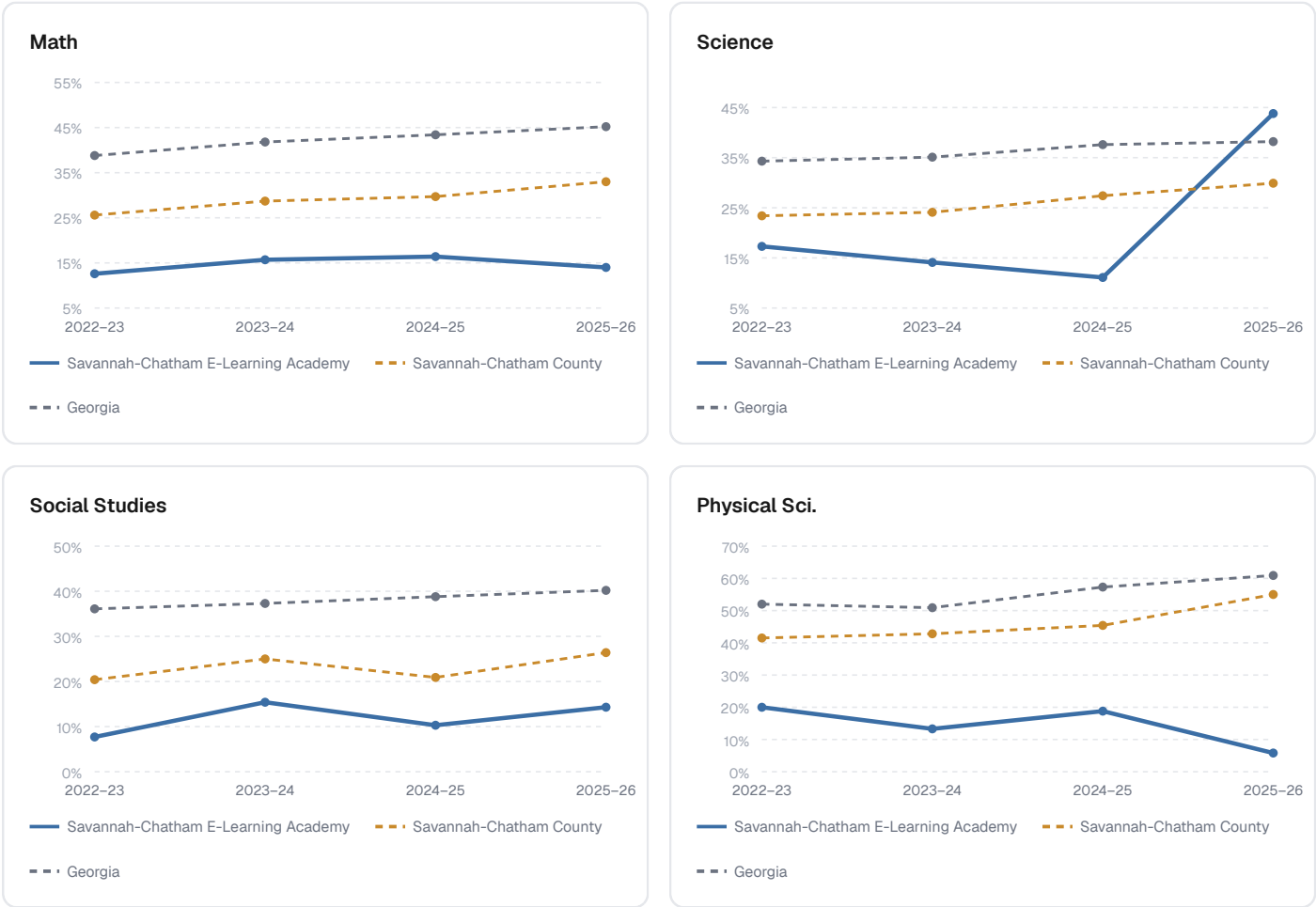
Percent of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished, with the change from last year and the distance to the district and state averages.
