Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science gained 9.6 points

87.7% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 78.1% in 2024–25.

Science has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

58.8% → 64.4% → 78.1% → 87.7% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+28.9 pts overall).

Grade 5 Science gained 27.4 points

94.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 66.7% in 2024–25.

Science is 49.5 points above the state

Savannah Classical Academy Charter School reported 87.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Social Studies is 60.7 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

87.1% here vs. 26.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math lost 6.6 points

66.7% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 73.3% in 2024–25.

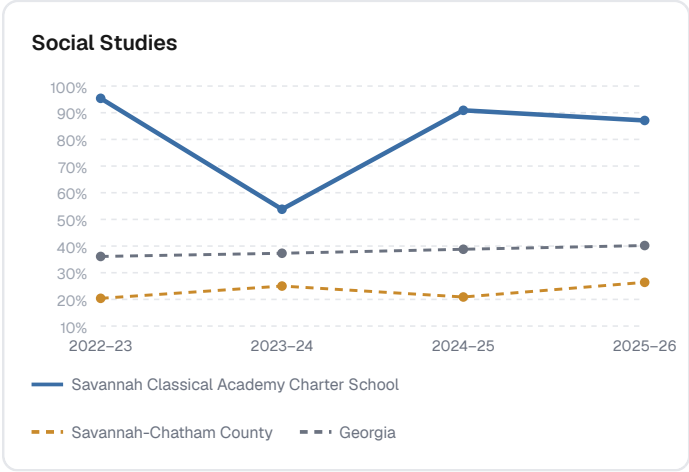
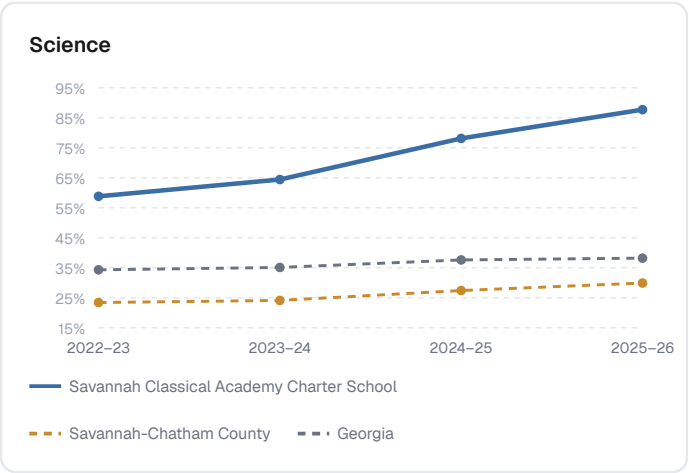
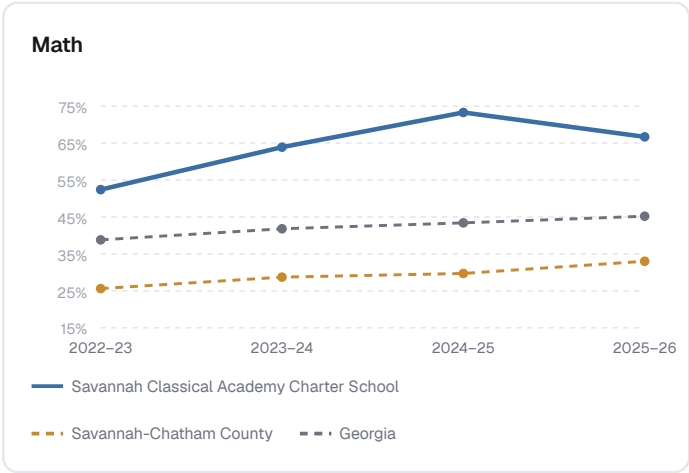
