WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math lost 3.3 points

28.3% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 31.6% in 2024–25.

Science has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

29.9% → 23.3% → 21.4% → 19.4% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (–10.5 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 14.3 points

Students with Disabilities sat 29.5 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 15.2 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math lost 7.4 points

30.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 38.1% in 2024–25.

Science is 18.8 points below the state

Southwest Elementary School reported 19.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

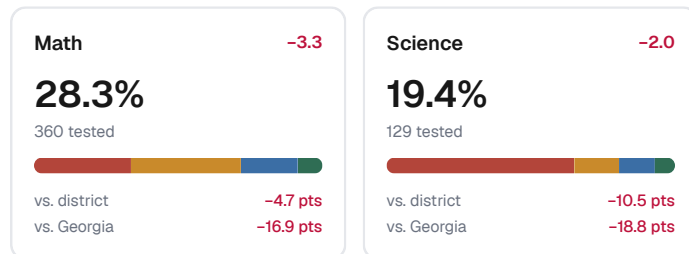
Science is 10.5 points below the Savannah-Chatham County average

Percent of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished, with the change from last year and the distance to the district and state averages.

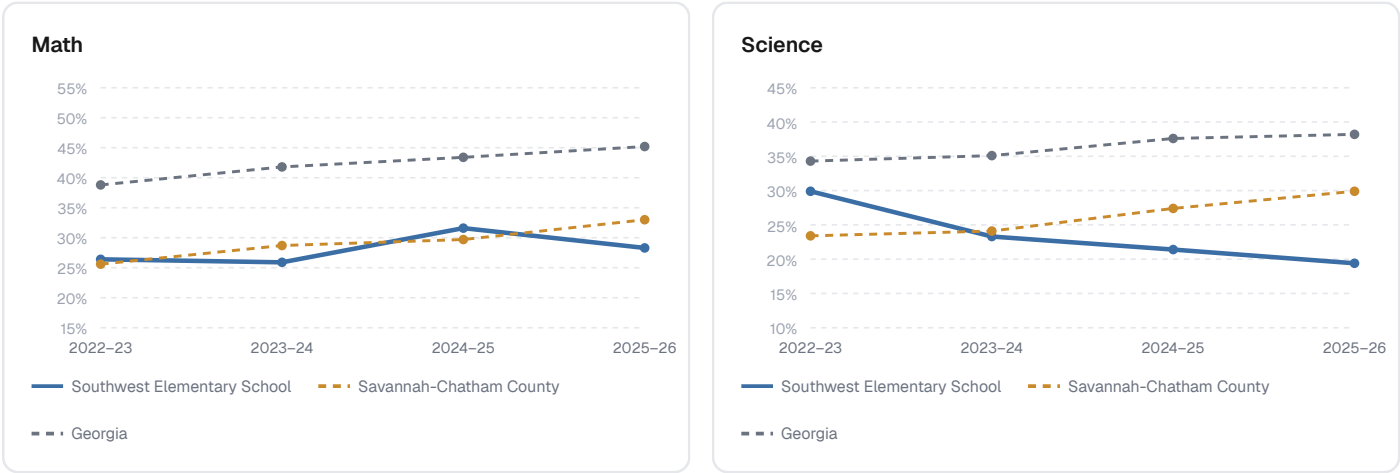


■ Beginning Learner
