Findings for 2025–26

Science gained 10.0 points

22.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 12.5% in 2024–25.

Grade 4 Math lost 11.9 points

14.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 26.5% in 2024–25.

Social Studies is 32.8 points below the state

Susie King Taylor Community School reported 7.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 40.2%.

Math is 20.5 points below the Savannah-Chatham County average

12.5% here vs. 33.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Social Studies gained 7.4 points

7.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 0.0% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Science gained 9.2 points

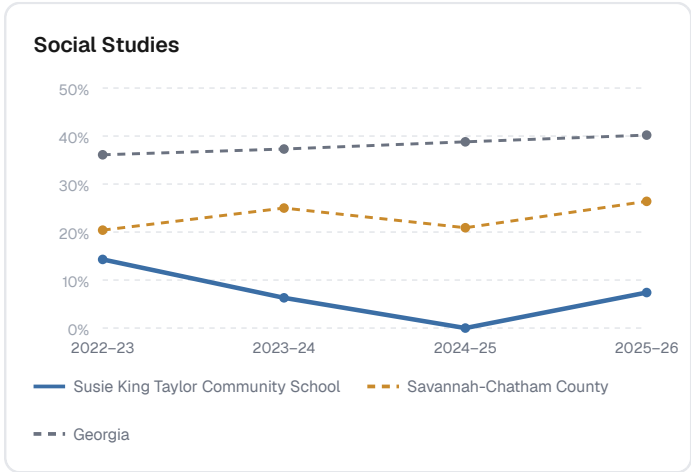
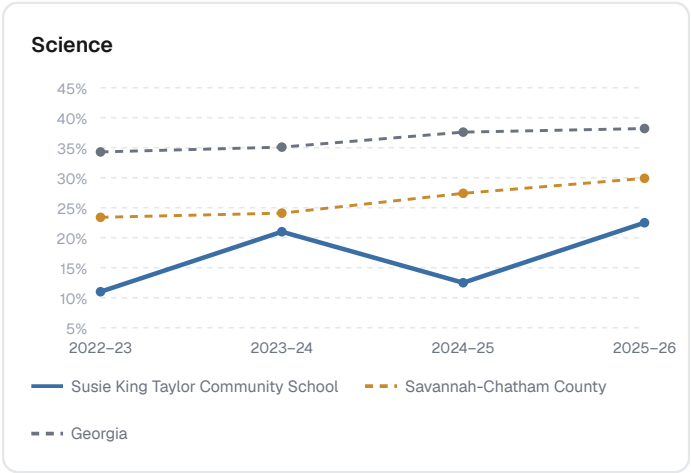
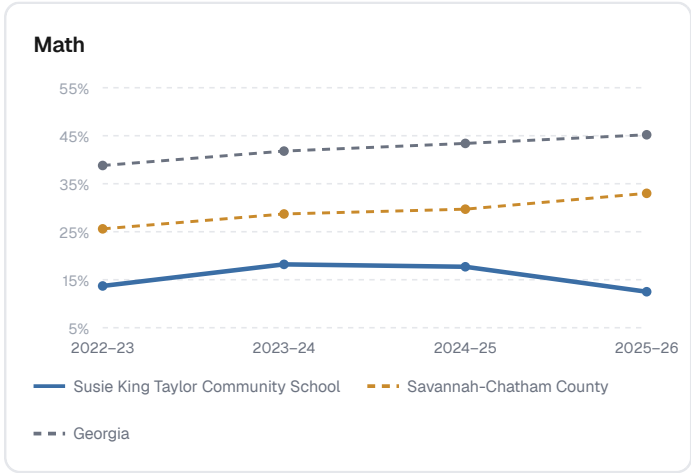
