Findings for 2025–26

Social Studies gained 15.8 points

47.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 31.8% in 2024–25.

Science has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

39.4% → 45.3% → 57.3% → 59.6% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+20.2 pts overall).

Grade 8 Social Studies gained 15.8 points

47.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 31.8% in 2024–25.

Algebra: C&C is 51.9 points above the state

Tybee Island Maritime Academy School reported 100.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 48.1%.

Algebra: C&C is 67.2 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

100.0% here vs. 32.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

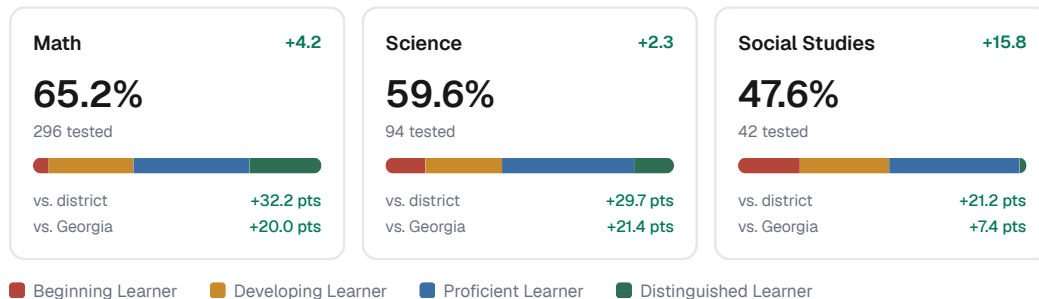
Math gained 4.2 points

Performance by subject

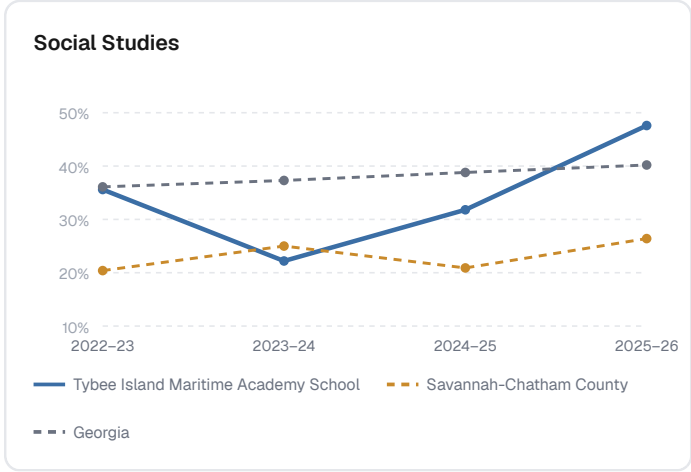
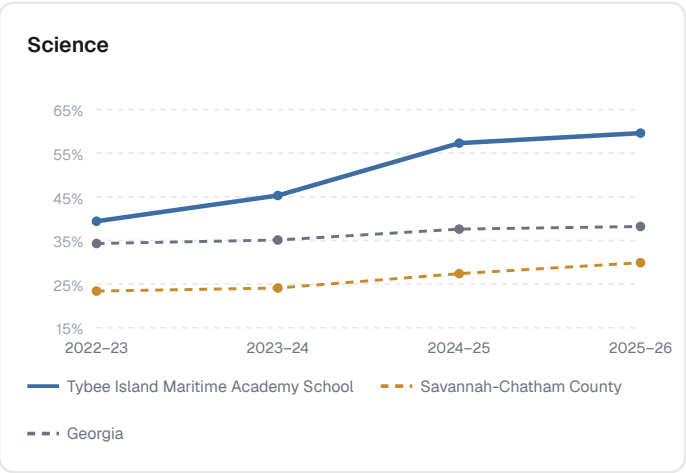
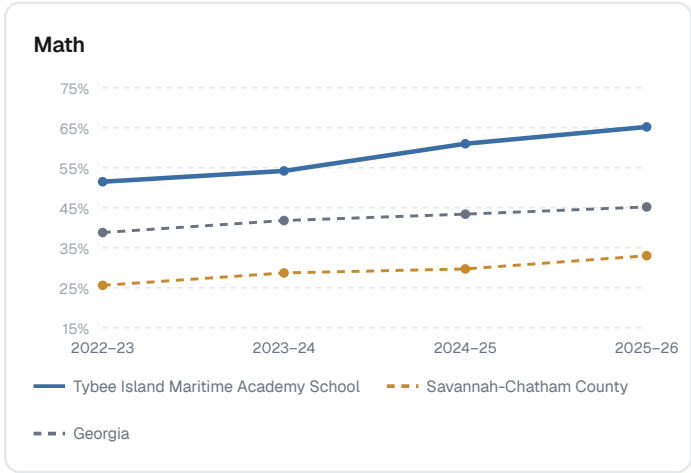
Percent of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished, with the change from last year and the distance to the district and state averages.
