## WHAT STANDS OUT

### Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

#### Math gained 5.9 points

39.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 33.7% in 2024–25.

#### Science has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

17.5% → 22.5% → 25.2% → 28.2% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+10.7 pts overall).

#### Grade 4 Math gained 8.6 points

53.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 44.4% in 2024–25.

#### Science is 10.0 points below the state

Windsor Forest Elementary School reported 28.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

#### Math is 6.6 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

39.6% here vs. 33.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

#### Science gained 3.0 points

28.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 25.2% in 2024–25.

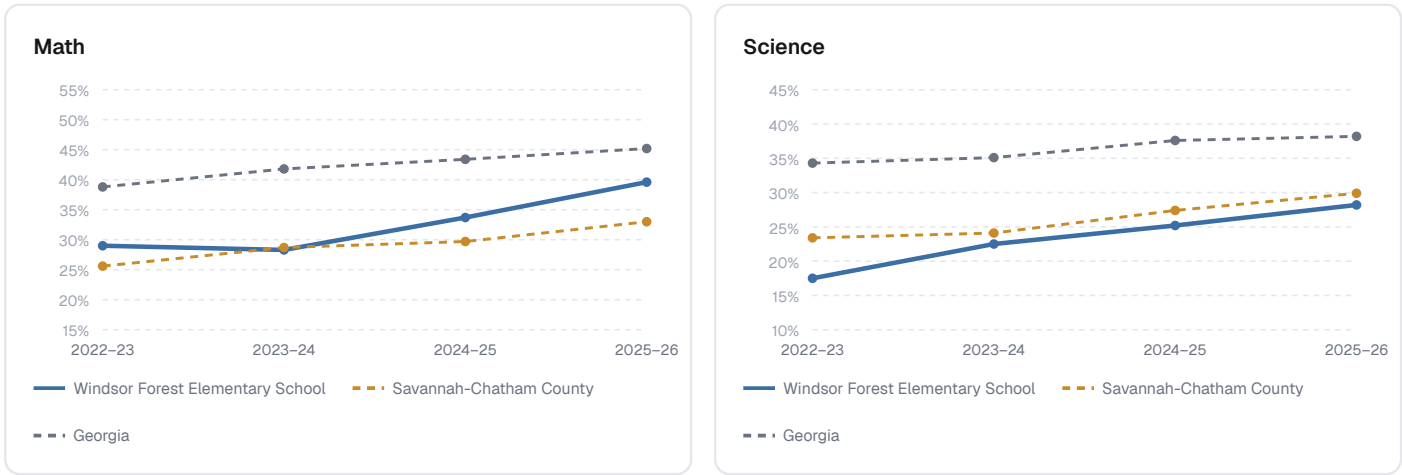
