Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Social Studies gained 18.0 points

55.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 37.8% in 2024–25.

Science has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

43.4% → 34.3% → 30.8% → 28.6% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (–14.8 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 5.2 points

Students with Disabilities sat 29.7 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 24.5 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 8 Social Studies gained 18.0 points

55.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 37.8% in 2024–25.

US History is 36.7 points above the state

Screven County reported 75.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.5%.

US History is 30.9 points above the First District average

75.2% here vs. 44.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

English Language Arts results for 2025–26 have not been published yet — GaDOE releases them after standard setting on the revised standards. Every total in this report covers the published subjects only.

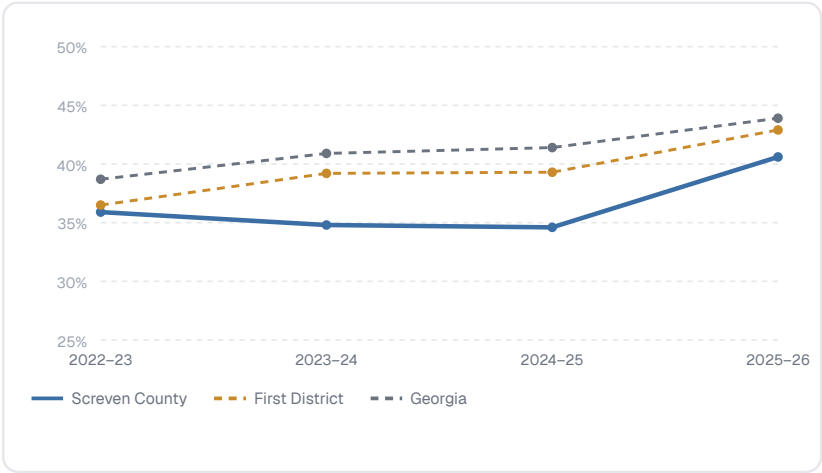

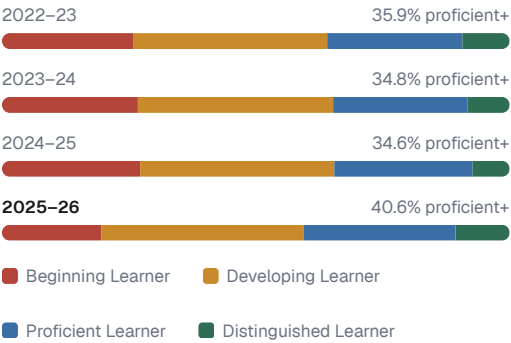
Trend against the region and the state

"Proficient or Distinguished" combines the top two of Georgia's four achievement levels and is the measure used for grade-level readiness. Cells marked "—" were withheld by the state because the group was too small to report without identifying individual students; they are excluded from averages rather than treated as zero. Where a student group is small, its size is shown beside the percentage and no comparison is drawn — a single student can move such a figure by tens of points, so it should not be read as a trend.
