Social Studies gained 18.0 points

Algebra: C&C is 42.6 points above the state

Screven County Middle School reported 90.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 48.1%.

Algebra: C&C is 30.3 points above the Screven County average

90.7% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 73.7% in 2024–25.

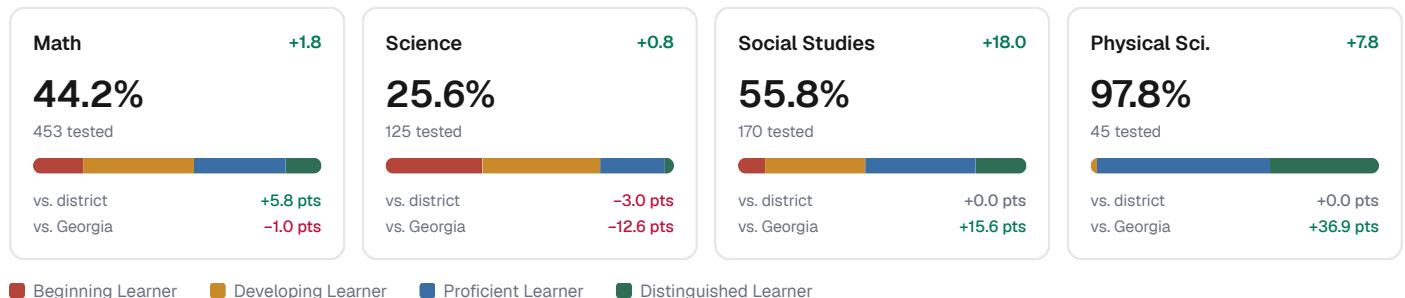
Grade 8 Math gained 10.4 points
