WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Algebra: C&C gained 9.5 points

37.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 27.9% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Science narrowed by 14.0 points

Limited English Proficient sat 32.8 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 18.8 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 5 Science lost 8.4 points

26.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 35.3% in 2024–25.

Biology is 19.9 points below the state

Tattnall County reported 27.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 47.2%.

Biology is 21.6 points below the First District average

27.3% here vs. 48.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

US History lost 7.8 points

56.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 64.0% in 2024–25.

English Language Arts results for 2025–26 have not been published yet — GaDOE releases them after standard setting on the revised standards. Every total in this report covers the published subjects only.

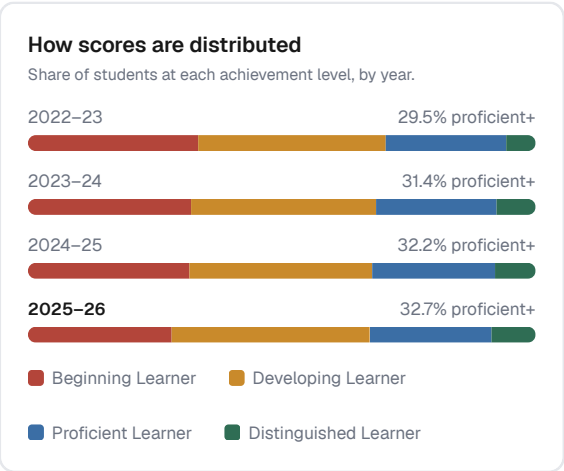
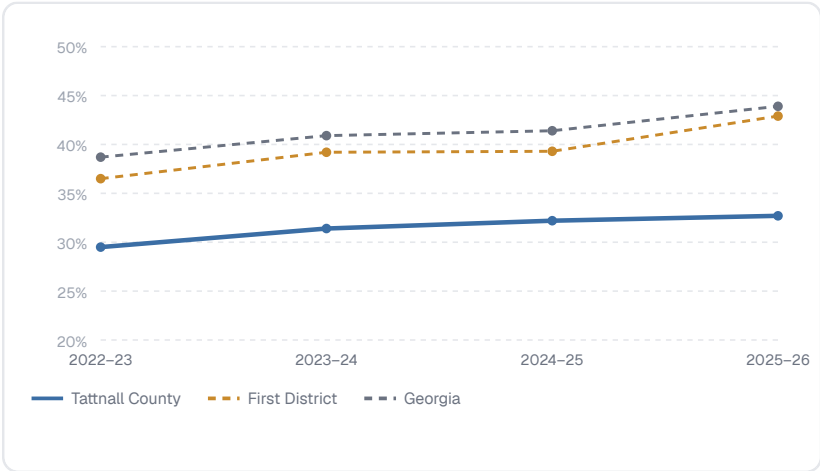

Source: Georgia Milestones district aggregates published by the Governor's Office of Student Achievement. "Proficient or Distinguished" combines the top two of Georgia's four achievement levels and is the measure used for grade-level readiness. Cells marked "—" were withheld by the state because the group was too small to report without identifying individual students; they are excluded from averages rather than treated as zero. Where a student group is small, its size is shown beside the percentage and no comparison is drawn — a single student can move such a figure by tens of points, so it should not be read as a trend.
