Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 8.1 points

36.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 28.3% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

27.5% → 28.0% → 28.3% → 36.4% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+8.9 pts overall).

The Limited English Proficient gap in Math widened by 16.2 points

Limited English Proficient sat 15.4 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 31.6 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 5 Math gained 11.2 points

35.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 23.9% in 2024–25.

Math is 8.8 points below the state

North Tattnall Elementary School reported 36.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Science is 13.6 points above the Tattnall County average

38.4% here vs. 24.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

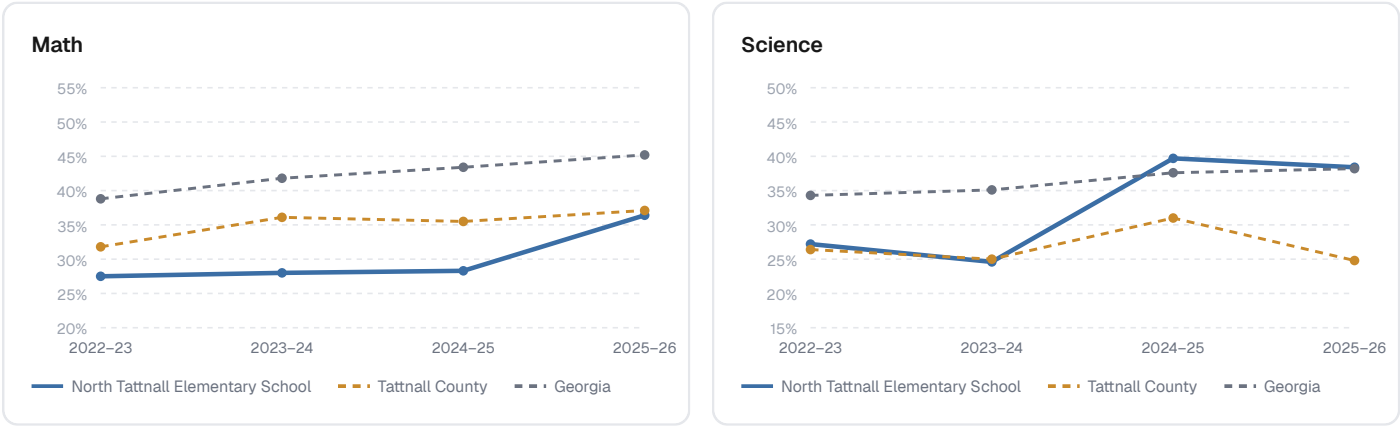
