WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Algebra: C&C gained 10.3 points

45.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 34.7% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Math narrowed by 24.0 points

Limited English Proficient sat 19.4 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 4.6 points ahead of them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math gained 22.3 points

59.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 37.4% in 2024–25.

US History is 18.8 points below the state

Toombs County reported 19.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.5%.

US History is 24.6 points below the First District average

19.7% here vs. 44.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math gained 8.4 points

41.3% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 32.9% in 2024–25.

English Language Arts results for 2025–26 have not been published yet — GaDOE releases them after standard setting on the revised standards. Every total in this report covers the published subjects only.

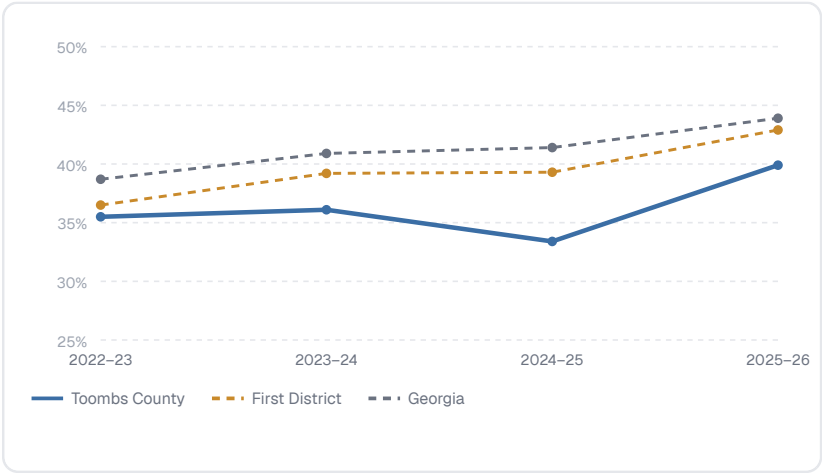

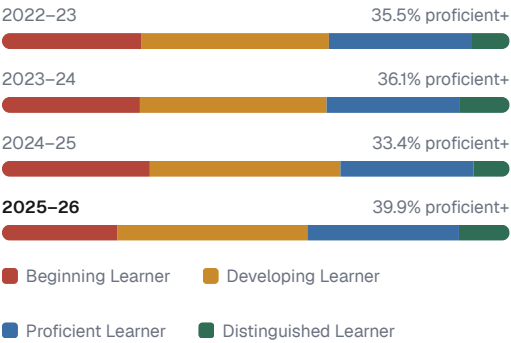
Trend against the region and the state

"Proficient or Distinguished" combines the top two of Georgia's four achievement levels and is the measure used for grade-level readiness. Cells marked "—" were withheld by the state because the group was too small to report without identifying individual students; they are excluded from averages rather than treated as zero. Where a student group is small, its size is shown beside the percentage and no comparison is drawn — a single student can move such a figure by tens of points, so it should not be read as a trend.
