WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 6.8 points

47.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 40.8% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Math narrowed by 22.7 points

Limited English Proficient sat 19.4 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 3.3 points ahead of them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math gained 28.3 points

65.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 37.3% in 2024–25.

Science is 19.8 points above the state

Lyons Upper Elementary reported 58.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 14.1 points above the Toombs County average

58.0% here vs. 43.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science lost 4.4 points

58.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 62.4% in 2024–25.

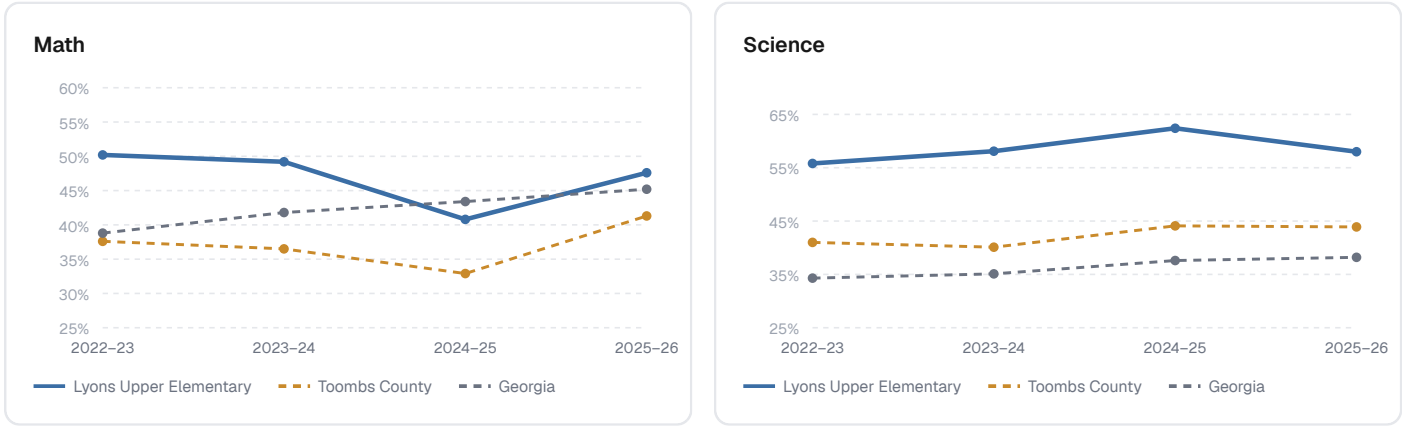
