Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 8.5 points

31.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 23.0% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math widened by 6.7 points

Students with Disabilities sat 18.0 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 24.7 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 6 Math gained 16.2 points

38.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 22.2% in 2024–25.

Social Studies is 17.3 points below the state

Toombs County Middle School reported 22.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 40.2%.

Science is 18.2 points below the Toombs County average

25.7% here vs. 43.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science lost 1.6 points

25.7% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 27.3% in 2024–25.

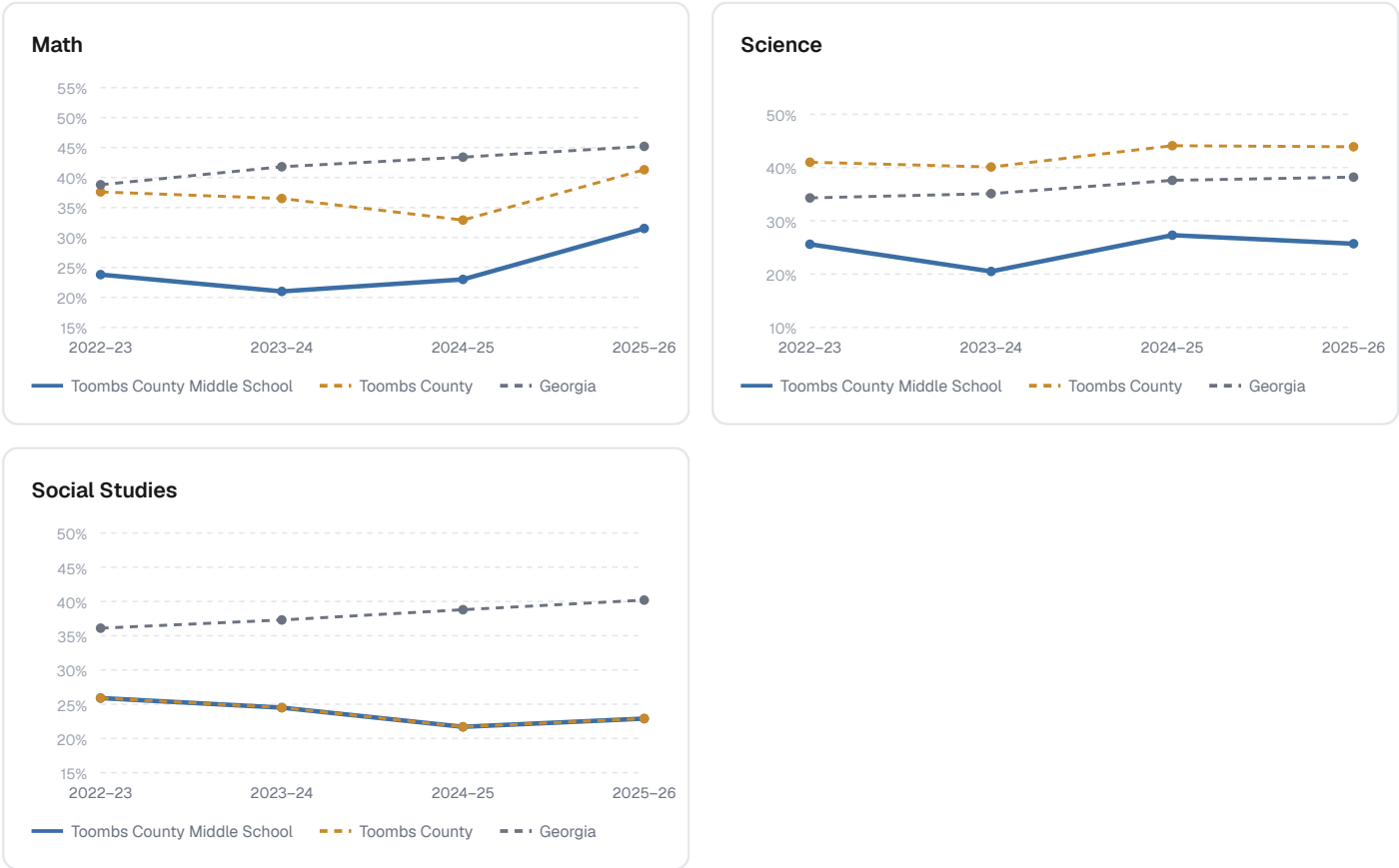
