Math gained 4.4 points

42.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 38.1% in 2024–25.

Grade 3 Math gained 13.9 points

47.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 33.7% in 2024–25.

Science gained 2.6 points

39.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 36.8% in 2024–25.

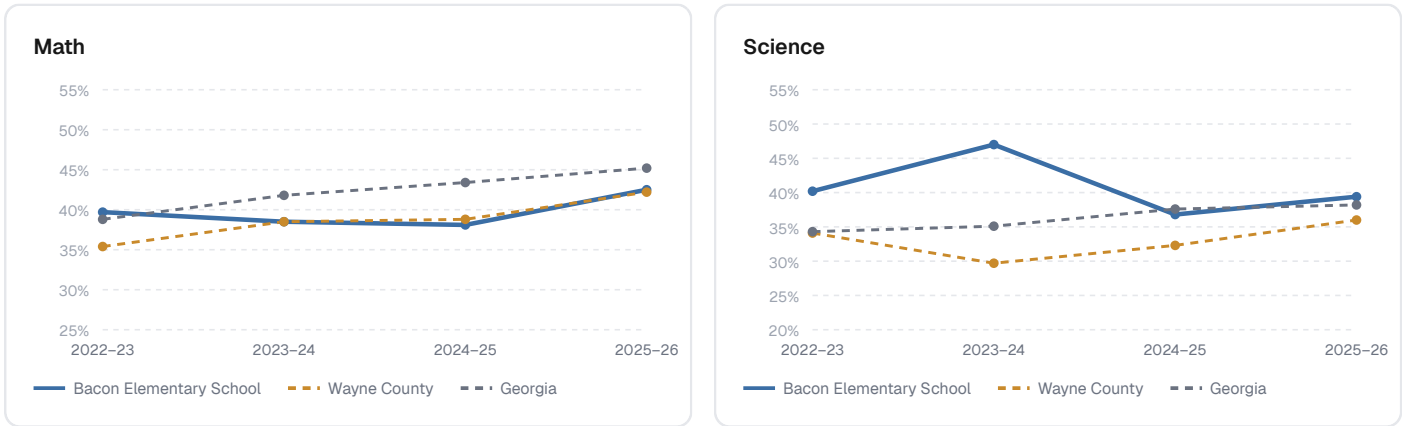
