Findings for 2025–26

Math gained 10.2 points

50.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 39.8% in 2024–25.

Grade 3 Math gained 17.7 points

54.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 37.1% in 2024–25.

Science is 17.0 points above the state

Screven Elementary School reported 55.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 19.2 points above the Wayne County average

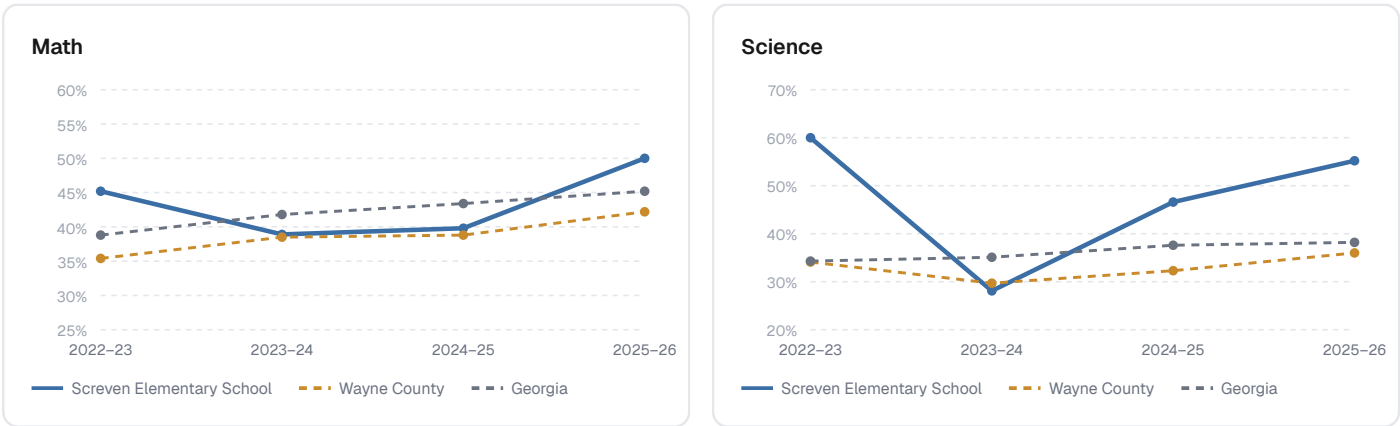
